### Coronavirus Pandemic 2020

### Parent/Carer Commitment

During the Coronavirus pandemic, Wirral Multi-Sports (WMS) continues to operate in the best interests of all team members, our children, their families and the wider community.

The health, safety and welfare of everyone is our highest priority. As your child will be within our care at a WMS sports coaching setting, we rely on your commitment to comply with all government guidance and other reasonable and necessary precautions in response to the Covid-19 virus, in order to ensure the continuing safety of all stakeholders at WMS.

Any safety system is as strong as its weakest link. In order to minimise the risk of infection or virus transmission within WMS, it is vital that everyone plays their part. In line with the direction given by government to stay alert, to comply with social-distancing advice and to restrict your contacts to the advised social groupings, it is imperative that you and your household continue to do so, to support the measures we are taking whilst caring for your child. We trust that everyone will support and understand that we will reserve the right to refuse admittance to any child from any family who are not following the government guidelines.

To highlight the seriousness of our intent to work together in partnership with all parents, we are asking you to read this document and by signing up to a WMS sports camp, as stated in our terms, you are committing to a declaration of your support for our endeavours to maintain a safe and healthy environment for everyone at WMS.

- We ask you not to attend in person or bring your child in if you or anyone in your household has or develops a fever, cough or loss of taste / smell. Please do not medicate your child before they come to WMS sports camps to reduce their temperature.
- If your child develops symptoms during the day, you will be called and asked to collect them immediately. Please ensure the emergency contact details we hold for you are up to date.

- I understand that I will be asked to keep my child at home for a minimum of two weeks should my child develop some of the coronavirus symptoms whilst in the care of WMS. I understand my contractual rights regarding refunds as set out in the terms & conditions agree to upon sign up. These terms enable WMS to continue to be financially viable during this pandemic whilst trying to be as fair as possible.
- I understand that during this period WMS will continue to not administer non-prescribed medication to reduce temperatures as it may mask my child's symptoms which could delay access to vital medical advice/assistance. Unless deemed that it will reduce risk of convulsions or soaring temperature and for the child's wellbeing whilst awaiting collection and isolation.
- If anyone in your household develops symptoms of coronavirus you are all eligible for testing. Once you have been tested, please inform us of the result so we can plan accordingly.
- We also ask that only one parent should attend drop off and collection.
- Please respect social distancing guidelines and markings at drop off / collection and leave the site promptly.
- I understand WMS will need to restrict the toys and items that my child brings from home to minimise the risk.
- We recognise that some children may find it challenging to separate from you initially on return to WMS. We are prepared for this and will work with you sensitively to comfort, reassure and settle them back in with us. Please feel free to phone us to check on them later, for your own peace of mind.
- Please provide your child with fresh, clean clothing, suitable for sports participation, each day.
- Not all of our team are returning in the summer. We are ensuring our most experienced coaches/teachers will deliver at this current time.
- You are encouraged to walk, cycle or drive to WMS. If you need to use public transport it is advised that you wear a face covering. Trikes or scooters should be taken home.
- I understand that WMS will be supporting my child's social and emotional wellbeing and that he/she will receive the usual appropriate comfort from team members as and when needed.
- I have been given information about and I am clear what measures the setting have put in place, to ensure the safety of all children and staff.
