

Amended Covid-19 Procedures

- **Bubbles:**
 - Allows safe fun participation/play in same group
 - reduces mass cross contamination
- **Drop Off:**
 - Staggered start times are 8:30 / 8:40 / 8:50 / 9:00 / 9:10.
During registration, you will be requested to use the space provided to specify your drop off preference. Order them from 1-5 (1 being most preferred & 5 being least preferred) (e.g. 1) 8:30, 2) 8:40, 3) 9:10, 4) 9:00, 5) 8:50).
Times will be allocated to preference order on a first-come-first-served basis until slot full ... once a time slot has reached 15 and is full we will then allocate second preferences.
There are no guarantees you will be allocated your most preferred drop off time but you can give yourself the best chance by booking as quickly as possible.
We will not admit children arriving earlier than their drop off time so please adhere to this drop off procedure to stop overcrowding and a safe and efficient registering process.
 - Queueing – You must be prepared to queue using the social distancing queue markers, moving forward as the queue progresses and markers ahead become clear.
 - We are using a one-way through flow system. Once you have registered your child they will be directed to the bubble and allocated bubble base. The parent/carer will be directed to and, must leave the premises via, the middle front facing door.
If your child attends the camp independently you must relay these procedures to them clearly.
 - Please use the hand sanitiser provided prior to approaching the registration desk. Avoid contact with all fixtures and fittings thereafter. Doors will be wedged open for ease of access.

- **Pick Up:**
 - Parents/Carers gather in rear/side PE car park at a safe social distance from each other from 2:50pm (even if we are outside for activities, we will return inside/tennis courts for consistency with this pick up procedure – avoiding confusion).
 - 1 bubble at a time will be escorted out where coach and child will identify (with a wave) parent/carer picking up. Process repeated until all children returned safely.
 - Parent/Carer & child must leave car park immediately to avoid unnecessary social overcrowding.
- **Other parental requirements:**
 - Please provide a water bottle clearly labelled with your child's name.
 - Please provide your own sun cream. We can no longer provide generically.
 - You must ensure your children wear fresh, clean (sports suitable) clothing each day.
 - Please provide packed lunch in a disposable bag where possible.
